Capstone is the culmination of the Flagship program. Students will spend a year studying Chinese, taking classes taught in Mandarin Chinese related to their major, and completing an internship using their language skills.

We currently offer capstones in Taipei and Monterey (US). Students interested in pursuing a career related to national security are encouraged to pursue the Monterey Capstone.

Reaching proficiency levels far beyond other language programs, you will be able to incorporate Chinese into all aspects of college life and your career path.

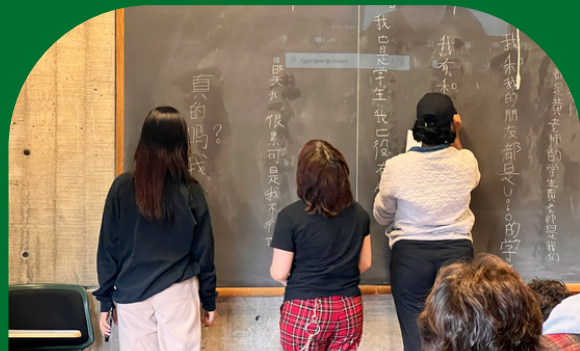

# PROGRAM STRUCTURE

1. Join Flagship - Students can apply to Flagship while they apply to the University of Oregon, or during their freshman or sophomore year at the University.
2. Take Chinese Class - Students take Chinese classes based on their proficiency level, including free tutoring.
3. Summer Study Abroad - Students take a summer abroad, in Mainland China or Taiwan. This is usually done after 2nd or 3rd year Chinese, and up to \$5,000 in scholarships may be provided.
4. Domain Training - Take Chinese classes that focus on your major.
5. Capstone - Students take classes related to their major at a Chinese-speaking university, then take an internship related to their major. Up to \$15,000 in scholarships may be provided.
